Bill Schroer Memorial Fund

The Bill Schroer Memorial Fund was established to honor this beloved husband and father, teacher, coach and citizen of Rochester Indiana. Bill was a member of two Rochester High School sectional championship basketball teams and served as captain, MVP and leading scorer in 1945. He also set a school free throw record and finished second in conference in scoring. He went on to Valparaiso University where he led the nation in free throw percentage and was captain, MVP, and top scorer as a senior. Coaching at Talma High School and then at Rochester High School for over 30 years, Bill was an author of sports history and served the community by his 20 years on the Rochester City Council.

Recipients of the Bill Schroer Memorial Fund will be awarded assistance with books and supplies for their college education.

1. Applicant must be Fulton County Indiana residents and graduated from a Rochester High School.
2. Must be enrolled in an accredited college or university, trade or vocational school.
