The Boomerang Sisterhood is a women's giving circle that draws upon the wisdom and resources of Miami County women to create a better society. Women participate by making an annual contribution of \$120 (payable in installments) to the Boomerang Sisterhood Fund, thereby becoming a voting member.

From these contributions, members of the Boomerang Sisterhood annually grant to charitable projects for the benefit of Miami County. Members don't have to worry about attending regular meetings or extended responsibilities, other than to cast an annual vote for projects they want to see supported. All gifts are pooled together in an endowment fund held by the Community Foundation. The earnings of which will be used for grants.

## Entry Procedures

**Please submit entries in accordance with the following guidelines:**

- 1) Complete the Boomerang Grant cover form and application. Once completed, this cover form and application should be the first and second pages of your application.
- 2) Document your application with up to two supplemental materials. Suggestions for supporting documentation include:
  - Information that supports factors or statistics used in your summary
  - Press clippings, brochures or fact sheets
  - Photographs (digital or film)
  - Promotional material
- 3) Neatly package the award application, summary and supporting materials, then mail or FAX to NICF, ATTN: Corinne Becknell Lucas, P.O. Box 807, Rochester, IN 46975. All entries must be in the NICF office by Friday September 1<sup>st</sup> to be considered for a grant.

**\* Please note that schools, both public and private are less likely to receive funding from the Boomerang Sisterhood.**

Confirmation emails will be sent for all grant proposals received. Those submitting a grant and NOT receiving a confirmation within one week should contact the Community Foundation Office. The Boomerang Sisterhood awards are decided at their annual gala. Details on the day and time will be made available to applicants selected as a finalist. Please be available to attend the event.
