

Randy Hughes Memorial Scholarship

In a time when young people around the Miami County area were cherished, few were more so than Randy Hughes.

He was an eccentric 15 year old who loved being outdoors hunting for deer, rabbit, and mushrooms, as well as playing sports for North Miami High School. Randy was a member of the varsity football and track teams and the junior varsity basketball team.

He had a life full of promise ahead of him, and his best years certainly were not behind him. On the morning of May 3, 1994, Randy was involved in a single-car crash on a county road in Miami County. He was taken to Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis, but perished a few days later.

To honor the legacy of this brilliant young man, a scholarship fund was set up in his memory. Friends and teachers felt this was the best way to remember Randy and to share his love of North Miami High School.
