

The Brooklyn A. Boo Memorial Scholarship

Brooklyn Boo was a North Judson-San Pierre High School student, remembered by those who knew her as a fun-loving girl who was very involved in her community and school. She had a passion for being in the water, and as a certified Indiana lifeguard, Brooklyn loved her job at the Bass Lake State Beach. Her hobbies included listening to music, shopping, and being with her friends.

She was an active participant in school organizations, including the National Honor Society, Student Council, the school newspaper, and she served in her Class Cabinet. She was recognized by *Who's Who Among American High School Students*, and she was also a National Honor Roll student.

Brooklyn tragically passed away in a car accident in 1998, and those who knew and loved her suffered a terrible loss. In order to commemorate Brooklyn, her family created a scholarship fund: The Brooklyn A. Boo Memorial Scholarship. It is designed to go to North Judson-San Pierre graduates who anticipate pursuing a degree in the medical field. In order to qualify, students must be in the top 20 percent of their graduating class and attend an Indiana high school for four years.

Through this scholarship, the Boo family hopes to honor the memory of Brooklyn and, in her name, provide assistance to students desiring to further their education.
